Research areas:

- (3) agents for cognitive and emotive simulations, including representations of human personality, emotions, emotional intelligence, understanding, sources of misunderstanding and conflict;
- (4) reliability, quality assurance, failure avoidance, and ethics; as well as
- (5) body of knowledge and
- (6) terminology of modeling and simulation.

He has over 600 publications -some translated in Chinese, German and Turkish;

including 65 books and proceedings
